The place of the practices and the concrete work that the	
students will develop will depend on the collaborating entities	
and the orientations of the professional tutor. Whenever they	
have signed the aforementioned agreement with the faculty,	
the practices may be carried out, among other places, in	
courts, public prosecutor's offices, solicitors, notaries, property	
registries, municipalities, Xunta de Galicia or other public	
entities, or in legal departments of private companies.	
The students will perform the tasks assigned to them in the	
entity, intended to complement their training in Law. The	
professional tutor appointed by the entity will be responsible	
for supervising the work of the student and the academic tutor	
appointed by the faculty will be responsible for the	
qualification. Students must make a report that will be given to	
their academic tutor at the conclusion of the work placement.
